REGULAR MEETING OF THE BOARD OF TRUSTEES

The last two regular meetings of the Board were held in St. Albert at the District Office on Monday, May 13th and May 27th, 2013.

GOOD NEWS

- Six cosmetology students from SACHS competed in a range of events at the recent provincial skills competitions. Three out of the six received medals including a gold medal in the category of Senior Hairstyling. The gold medalist, Chelsey now moves on to National Skills and will represent Skills Team Alberta on Vancouver on June 4th and 5th.
- Ecole Notre Dame School celebrated the rededication of Notre Dame School last week with special guests Jeff Johnson, Minister of Education and Maureen Kubenic, MLA for Barrhead-Morinville-Westlock. The celebration included a blessing of the new modular wing with the assistance of Father Ignacy.
- The district received a \$10,000 healthy schools initiative grant that will be utilized by 4 schools (J.J. Nearing, Ecole Father Jan, Legal & MCHS). They will meet as a committee to make choices that will best utilize this funding.

- The board approved the 2014-2017 Capital Plan which includes five requests, of which the top two priorities are the SACHS modernization and a new elementary school in Morinville.
