## REGULAR MEETING OF THE BOARD OF TRUSTEES

The last regular meeting of the Board was at the District Office, on Monday, October 26, 2015.

#### **GOOD NEWS**

- ESSMY students journeyed to Costa Rica to learn about and contribute to the humanitarian work being done in San Jose, in particular at orphanages. The group worked with the youth, as well as fixed up and painted the orphanage. It was an amazing experience for our ESSMY students.
- J.J. Nearing School gathered 400 bags of food and toiletries to donate to the St. Vincent de Paul Society; this was such a tremendous demonstration of generosity.
- SACHS held Voice for Hunger, a Skyhawk talent show held prior to Thanksgiving. We were blessed to see the many talents of our students and their overwhelming generosity. Over 1300 items/dollars were dropped off at the St. Albert Food Bank! Our Skyhawk family is incredible.
- ESSMY students participated in the Run for Christ to raise money for Development and Peace. Over \$1,100 will go towards the District partnership to rebuild schools in the Philippines.
- École Notre Dame Students focused their October effort on a service project to help those in need. As part of the school's Thanksgiving Celebration, the school community collected 320 lbs. of food for the Morinville Food Bank. Thank you to all families who donated items.
