POLICY REVIEW FRAMEWORK

Superintendent of Schools, D. Keohane reviewed revised **Policy 4**: Trustee Code of Conduct focusing on new policy statements. There were no significant changes presented for **Policy 3**: Role of the Trustee. Both policies will move to the Regular meeting on October 28, 2019 for approval or deferral if considered necessary.

PROVINCIAL ACHIEVEMENT TESTS AND DIPLOMA EXAMS

Assistant Superintendent, Dr. R. Nixon provided a preliminary update on Grade 6 and Grade 9 PAT Results and Gr 12 Diploma Results. Elementary, junior and senior high English students outperformed the province at the Acceptable Standard and Standard of Excellence in all core subjects. Elementary and junior high French students struggled to keep pace with students provincially in core subjects. Grade 12 French students outperformed the province at the Acceptable Standard of Excellence by 1% on average in core subjects.
