Pre-Kindergarten

Greater St. Albert Catholic Schools' pre-kindergarten program offers learning opportunities in all areas of Early Childhood development. Our staff includes certified teachers, educational assistants and specialists/ therapists who help children of all abilities become confident learners.

Your child will gain skills through play, inquiry, creativity, problem solving, social interaction as well as early literacy, language and numeracy activities.

- Our programs are designed for children 2.8 to 4.8 years of age who qualify for Alberta Education funding for a one or two year placement in our program.
- · Children who do not qualify for funding may be enrolled for their year prior to kindergarten if space permits. Fees apply.


PRE-KINDERGARTEN SCREENING



Kindergarten

FRENCH IMMERSION

Getting an early start gives your child more time to become comfortable with a French language classroom before moving to grade one

REGULAR KINDERGARTEN

This is half day programming for children. Programs are offered in either morning or afternoon classes.

FULL DAY KINDERGARTEN

This is a program choice for families. In the full day program, your child will experience expanded learning opportunities. Fees apply.

PROGRESSIVE KINDERGARTEN

Another program of choice that offers half day classes until the end of March. For the remainder of the year, children attend full day which provides an excellent transition to grade one. Fees apply.
