- Report bullying incidents ASAP!
 - o Addressing issues as they occur will provide the best result for everyone involve
 - Immediate reporting will prevent issues from worsening over time and allow both parents and staff to be able to act quickly and minimize future incidents
- Report bullying incidents to the staff member with the closest relationship to your child. Principals will always be notified
