



## ASBOA Past President's Scholarship Award Criteria and Application Form

### BACKGROUND:

On October 15, 2018, the Board of Trustees was presented with the Association of School Business Officials of Alberta (ASBOA) **Past President's Scholarship**. The presentation by the Executive Director of ASBOA and the current Past President of ASBOA, was in recognition of secretary treasurer Schlag's three years on the association executive: as vice-president in 2015-16, as president in 2016-17, and in 2017-18 as past president, which concluded on June 30, 2018. In recognition of her contributions, the Board was provided a plaque, along with a cheque for \$1,500 for scholarship opportunities to a student(s) who demonstrated leadership and wished to pursue a secondary education in the business, financial and/or management field, with a preference for school business.

### CRITERIA:

The student applying for this award must be a grade 12 student continuing to post-secondary studies in the business, financial and/or management field, in 2019-2020. In keeping with the Mission, Vision, and Values of the District, the successful candidate must reflect Catholic/Christian values in his/her lifestyle and studies. He/she must have demonstrated leadership, integrity, and genuine friendliness in his/her relationship with others. This student must be dedicated and persevering in his/her studies, intending to make a meaningful contribution to the business/school community in the future.
