## ENGLISH AS A SECOND LANGUAGE (ESL)

## Background

The Division supports the provision of an English as a Second Language Program for students requiring assistance with the acquisition of basic English language skills.

English as a Second Language programming (ESL) is designed to provide specialized service for students who require assistance in acquiring an English language foundation.

## Guidelines

- 1. Eligibility for the program shall be determined by a student's linguistic, cultural and academic needs.
- 2. The program may vary in length and intensity depending on the student's needs.
- 3. The program shall follow the policies, guidelines and procedures established by Alberta Education.
- 4. Program availability within the Division will be determined annually based upon:
  - 4.1 The number of students requiring the program.
  - 4.2 The availability of appropriate facilities and qualified staff.
  - 4.3 Program costs.
  - 4.4 Other factors considered relevant by the Board.

## Procedures

- 1. Each year Principals will submit to the Superintendent a list of students requiring ESL instruction.
- 2. If the number of students identified warrant the establishment of an ESL program, the Superintendent, in consultation with school-based staff, will establish a program to meet those needs.
- 3. If an appropriate program cannot be offered in the Division, arrangements may be made to purchase services from another jurisdiction.
- 4. Written parental approval is required before students are registered in an ESL program.
