TRAFFIC AND PARKING CONTROL

Background

Efficient management of staff and student parking contributes to the creation of a safe environment for students, employees and the public.

The Division shall provide adequate parking facilities for its employees and may provide limited parking for students where a need exists and there is adequate space.

Procedures

- 1. The Division does not assume any responsibility or liability for vehicles parked on its property.
- 2. Parking fees may be set annually to recover a portion of capital, operating and maintenance costs.
- 3. Regulations and fee recommendations for student parking may be determined by the Principal, subject to Board approval.
- 4. Traffic control in school bus lanes shall be regulated by the Secretary-Treasurer by:
 - 4.1 Establishing school bus lanes at all Division schools.
 - 4.2 Arranging for appropriate signage to restrict and/or prohibit parking in school bus lanes.
 - 4.3 Issuing appropriate violation warning notices where required.
 - 4.4 Arranging for the legal ticketing or removal of offending vehicles when necessary.
