REGULAR MEETING OF THE BOARD OF TRUSTEES

The last regular meeting of the Board was held at the District Office, on Monday, February 9, 2015.

GOOD NEWS

- Congratulations to **Jamie Robertson** at **Neil M. Ross School** for being recognized as this month's Rotary Teacher of the Month by the St. Albert Rotary Club.
- Congratulations to Cathy Traynor and Dolores Andressen for their work in establishing the
 Healthy Schools Initiative in our schools. Delores established the initiative back in 2011 at
 Bertha Kennedy School. Her success with the initiative and Cathy Traynor's passion for school
 health promotion has now expanded to include ten district schools in Morinville and St. Albert.
 This past month their efforts were recognized with an Award of Distinction in support of building
 healthy school communities. This was a provincial award in the category of School District
 Champions.
- The Capital sub-committee highlighted the good news that the **SACHS** modernization is progressing with the full scope as requested in the Capital Plan. Thank you to administration for their work in advocating for the full scope to gain the support from the provincial government needed to move this forward.

- Assistant Superintendent D. Quick provided a Faith and Spiritual Initiatives update highlighting:
 - o Retreats for staff and students are being implemented in schools; this is in alignment with the goals in the 3-Year Education plan,
 - o The District commitment to raise \$200,000 over the next few years to support Canadian Development and Peace.
 - o The relationships with Parish Priests that are strengthening in all school communities.
- Secretary-treasurer D. Schlag presented reports on the current position and projects planned for operations and maintenance as well as those scheduled infrastructure maintenance and renewal projects in the District.
