- An update was provided on the Open Classroom concept and how it supports pedagogy and instruction that is consistent with GSACRD's approach to learning and engaging students.
- Secretary-treasurer Schlag updated the Board on a few budget considerations for the coming school year based on the recent provincial announcement. Some of the assumptions that will impact the budgeting process include: two collective agreements requiring re-negotiation at Aug 31, 2016, increase in benefit costs, and confirmation of class size standards for allocation purposes. The Board is pleased the government recognized education as a priority.
