ACTION & CONSENT ITEMS

- The Board approved the authorization of 17 locally developed courses including Fit For Life 7, Leadership 7-8-9, Math Advantage 9, Sports Recreation 8, Avid Readers 5, Biology 35IB, Film Studies 15-25-35, Forensics Science 35, and Jazz 15-25-35 to name a few.
- The Board reviewed the recent Board Policy 18 Naming of Schools with no changes.
- The Board introduced 1st reading of the Laura Bird Memorial Beacon of Hope Award which honors her legacy by recognizing a staff member who demonstrates witness to Jesus Christ to the most needy and in the most selfless manner possible.

SUPERINTENDENT'S REPORT

- Highlights from the Accountability Pillar Report were shared, noting that,
 - three out of four high school students across the District are scholarship eligible,
 - o more than 90% of FNMI students graduate within three years and
 - satisfaction levels with providing safe and caring schools, quality education, parental involvement and school improvement are all very high.

The report will be updated in the fall to include Diploma and Provincial Achievement Tests Results.

- Results from the Gallup Poll, which measures engagement levels, highlighted that employee engagement across the District has reached its highest level in eight years. High levels of employee engagement impacts student success in school, and engagement levels among staff are also a predictor of professional success.
- An update on Faith Initiatives across the District highlighted the outstanding progress on many of the charitable works District schools were involved in including, raising funds for the building of Pope Francis School, supporting the Fort McMurray Fire Relief efforts and the annual Sign of Hope Campaign. Thank you to all of the school communities for their generosity!

- The Board will be responding to the Government's Municipal Act Legislation as it impacts school boards.
- The Board will be reviewing the 2016-2017 Budget for approval purposes on June 27, 2016.
