THE REGULAR MEETING OF THE BOARD OF TRUSTEES Meeting was held at the District Office, on Monday, January 17, 2017.

GOOD NEWS

- There was overwhelming response to the parent session the District hosted on January 17, 2017 at ESSMY on the topic of Parenting Youth in a Stressful World. Dr. Stan Kutcher who is the presenter of the session is a renowned Psychologist and leading expert on Youth Mental Health and Wellness. He is a Professor at Dalhousie University and the District was blessed to have this opportunity.
- Several Board members were witness to the impact of the District initiative on supporting those imprisoned during a recent visit to the Remand Center. The practice of decorating and providing Christmas bags to inmates is making a difference and thank you to all the schools, students and families supporting this initiative which is aligned with Catholic teachings.
- The generosity and creativity of **St. Albert Catholic High School students** was shared during the holiday season as Christmas spirit was evident at Sturgeon Community Hospital.
