We recognize that each child is unique in their learning. In addition to traditional school programs, we also provide specialized education programs that are listed below.

PRE-KINDERGARTEN

Greater St. Albert Catholic Schools has five Pre-kindergarten programs. They provide early intervention to young children in inclusive learning environments. Programs are located in St. Albert, Morinville and Legal. The programs offer integrated, structured, individualized half-day classes for children aged 2 1/2 years (if student qualifies for Alberta Education's PUF funding) to 4 1/2 years. The emphasis is on learning through play in a language and literacy-rich environment.

KINDERGARTEN FULL-DAY, HALF-DAY AND PROGRESSIVE OPTIONS

Starting kindergarten is a big step for you and your child. We want this important first step toward a Catholic education to be a memorable experience for your family. Greater St. Albert Schools offer a range of kindergarten programs to meet the varying needs of families in our communities. This includes

half-day options, full-day options that run the entire week or programs that are full-day where children attend on alternating days.

Our programs also include English and French immersion options that are Christcentered. We nurture the physical, emotional, intellectual, social, and spiritual needs of your child. Play, exploration, and learning about Jesus are part of the program. Our approach in all of our kindergarten classrooms is to provide a learning environment that balances a focus on discovery and play with teacher instruction to develop your child as a confident learner going into grade one.

INTERNATIONAL BACCALAUREATE 7 TO 12

The International Baccalaureate Programme (IB) is a rigorous pre-university course of study leading to examinations that meet the needs of highly motivated academic students. Students preparing to enter the Pre-IB Programme should have high marks in Grade 9 (minimum 80% average). At the junior high level the IB program is not exclusive to high academics. It is an enriched program that is folded into the curriculum and allows for differentiated instruction. Please contact both our IB schools for more information.

Greater St. Albert Catholic Schools prides itself on its French Immersion programs, offering one of the largest single track programs in Alberta. Many parents and students consider knowledge of more than one language a valuable investment in the future. Our region is filled with families whose French grandparents and great grandparents settled the region in the early part of this century and the latter part of the previous century. This is evident in the many town and street names that pay tribute to them.

Approximately 1,600 of our students are enrolled in this program. French Immersion students have the option of two different program structures. Morinville schools offer dual-track French immersion where parallel English and French Immersion classes are taught. Several schools in St. Albert offer a singletrack approach which features an environment dedicated entirely to French Immersion.
