#### ACTION & CONSENT ITEMS

- The Board reviewed and updated Policy 19 Acknowledging Territories of Indigenous Communities at District Events.
- The Board approved Guiding Principles that will inform any decisions made on boundaries and programming, for the 2017-2018 Public Consultation Process for St. Kateri Tekakwitha Academy in Morinville
- The Board updated and approved Locally Developed Courses including Competencies in Math 15, Film and Media Art 15-25-35 and Indigenous Studies 35. The Indigenous Studies 35 course will be eligible for dual-credit.
- As part of the budget cycle, the Board approved the 2017-2018 Principles for the Basis of Allocations to Schools which includes maintaining class sizes at current levels and updating the principles to align with the two new Regulations on School Fees & School Transportation.

#### SUPERINTENDENT'S REPORT

- Assistant superintendent McGuinness updated the Board on the Field Trip Report. It was discussed the changing nature of International travel.
- Assistant superintendent Nixon updated the Board on the District's plans to implement a Nutrition Pilot based on recent grant funds from the province. The Nutrition Pilot will involve three schools (École Notre Dame, G.H. Primeau and Legal) that do not currently receive support. Community partners currently provide support to St. Albert Schools.

- The Board will be approving School Fee Schedules for 2017-2018.
- The Board will be amending Policy 2 Role of the Board, by adding a section on Fees.
