Just today, The Hon. Adriana LaGrange, Minister of Education, explained that, "As announced yesterday by Premier Kenney during the release of Alberta's Relaunch Strategy, the province has made the decision to not have students return to in-school classes for the remainder of the academic year." The Minister also confirmed that while a re-entry plan is the focus of current ministry discussions, no decisions have been made about specifics regarding this plan. As is the case in many jurisdictions in Alberta, GSACRD will offer summer school for high school students (grades 9 to 12). All classes will be delivered entirely online, and there will be no diploma courses.
