Dear Students, Parents/Legal Guardians, and Staff:

To keep pace with the changes happening in our Division regarding school start-up, I would like to share the following information, some of which you may know already and some of which are changes as of this week:

- **Staggered Start for K-9 Face-to-Face Students:**
 - Aug. 31, 2020: Only students who have last names beginning (A-K) will attend school on this day.
 - Sept. 1, 2020: Only students who have the last names beginning (L-Z) will attend school on this day.
- **Regular Classes:**
 - Sept. 2, 2020: Regular classes resume on this day.
- **Delayed Start for K-9 Online Students:**
 - Sept. 8, 2020: Online education classes for K-9 students will begin, which is a delayed start for these students.
- **Aug. 28 – Sept. 4, 2020:**
 - Principals will continue to confirm online registrations. Online teachers will work with Division staff to prepare for the start-up. Online teachers will contact parents to share details about school start-up (schedules, routines, and where and how to access materials).

Online students do not come to school until September 8th unless they are in high school.

- **Pre-Kindergarten Programs and High Schools (Grades 10, 11, and 12) and MCHS (Grades 9-12)**
 - These programs and schools will follow their own schedules for school entry.

I will send my regular weekly communication on Friday, but I wanted to share with you these scheduling changes to ensure that you were apprised of them as early as possible.
