

Also, as a part of **BK's** building positive community relations, our students created gift bags with a "virtual" hug included for our senior friends at River Ridge Seniors Community.

Legal School once again contributed to a town-wide Christmas Hamper drive coordinated by the St. Emile Men of Service (formerly the Knights of Columbus) in conjunction with École Citadelle.
