# Division Results Review 2018-2019

### Introduction

To further our work on our *Division's Three-Year Education Plan 2019-2022*, *Outcome One: Alberta's Students Are Successful*, the Board is provided with our students' results (provincial achievement tests and diploma examinations), our Division vision of assessment and professional learning support, and implications for celebration and future focus.

### Provincial Requirements for Teacher Assessment

The newly mandated *Alberta Teaching Quality Standard* (Sept. 1, 2019) Section 3c requires that teachers gather information about students' learning using a "balance" of "formative" (during teaching) and "summative" assessment (after instruction), with an emphasis on "accurate, constructive, timely feedback."

# Division Pedagogical Vision and Professional Learning Support



Our Division's pedagogical vision emphasizes a balance of formative and summative assessment, with a focus on six "practice progressions": (1) know the learning intention, (2) identify success criteria, (3) seek feedback to improve, (4) collaborate to learn, (5) leverage technology, and (6) own and care about their learning and see relevance to everyday life.

To assist administrators with using summative assessment information, we hold a "data day", which provides a step-by-step process to analyze Accountability Pillar, PAT and DIP results, District Satisfaction Survey and Gallup Q12 results to determine areas of importance to set Faith and Learning goals during school

# Grade 3 Student Learning Assessment (SLA) and Professional Learning Support

Our Division continues to. support grade three teachers who choose to participate in administering one or more parts of the Grade 3 Student Learning Assessment (English language arts performance task; a math performance task; English language arts multiple-choice questions; math multiple-choice questions). For the last three years, including this year, most grade three teachers in our Division chose to administer one or more parts of the SLA at the start of the school year, and they took part in the Division PD (2 sessions). The teachers who took part reported that the SLA has been a helpful diagnostic assessment (administered before instruction) to assist them to identify gaps in students' learning to shape their teaching to be responsive to students' needs. They also valued collaboratively assessing students' work and sharing research-based teaching strategies to address student needs.



### Grade 6 Provincial Achievement Test Results

Figure 1.0 shows how well our Grade 6 students achieved *compared to the Province* (Achievement Column), improved *compared to the Division Three-Year Average* (Improvement Column), and performed *Overall* (Overall Column uses a statistical formula to determine the results of achievement and improvement for 2019). We have no areas of required improvement to report to the province in Grade 6.

Grade 9 students performed at Excellent or Good for 5 out of 10 standards at the Acceptable Standard for ALL Core Subjects. Grade 9 students outperformed (+14.5) the province the Acceptable Standard for ALL core subjects.

### STANDARD OF EXCELLENCE

Grade 9 students perform at Excellent or Good for 2 out of 10 standards at the Standard of Excellence for ALL Core Subjects. Grade 9 students performed slightly below (-1.9) the province at the Standard of Excellence for ALL core subjects.

# Looking Ahead: Areas of Focus for Grade 9

In reviewing the English/French/ K & E analysis (Appendix, Figure 5.0), Grade 9 French students have improved at the Acceptable Standard, but six-year trends (Appendix, Figure 6.0) indicate that French students require support to improve at the Standard of Excellence in French Language Arts, Math, and Science. Professional learning supports will be concentered in Math 9 (Part A & B) and FLA 9 (Reading-associating meaning; Writing- business letter).



### Diploma Results

We have **two areas** (English Language Arts 30-2, Acceptable Standard; French Language Arts 30-1, Acceptable Standard) to report to the province for continuous improvement.

### ACCEPTABLE STANDARD

Grade 12 students performed at Excellent or Good for 6 out of 9 standards at the Acceptable Standard for ALL Core Subjects. Grade 12 students performed about the same (+0.8) as the province at the Acceptable Standard for ALL core

### STANDARD OF EXCELLENCE

Grade 12 students performed at Excellent or Good for 6 out of 9 standards at the Standard of Excellence for ALL Core Subjects. Grade 12 students outperformed (+2.2) the province at the Standard of Excellence for ALL core subjects.

While we have many areas to celebrate as noted in Figure 6.0, below, we also have two areas (English Language Arts 30-2, Acceptable Standard; French Language Arts 30-1, Acceptable Standard) to report to the province for continuous improvement. We aim to focus on these subjects and Social 30-1 as well as two sciences.

In addition to a subject-based focus for professional learning support, we will continue to improve our online learning and summer school learning pathways for students. From 2015-present, between 50-65 students have taken core courses either online or in summer school. These students have *underperformed* compared to the province (-8%) at the Acceptable Standard. Last year, 10 students took ELA 30-1 online or in summer school and underperformed (Division Three-Year Average/Province 2019: -6.1/-6.8) at the Acceptable Standard and at the Standard of Excellence (-5.6/-12.3). Similarly, 11 students took Social 30-1 online/summer school underperformed (-0.6/-14) at the Acceptable Standard. Students who completed Social 30-2 and Chemistry 30 online or in summer school underperformed compared to regular stream students in 2019.

### Looking Ahead: Areas of Focus in High School

To address declines in online and summer school learning, we have dedicated a half-time administrator working side-by-side with iLearn students and staff to ensure that students have updated course materials that align with the required standards to be taught. Additionally, our professional learning for high school will focus overall on the following areas:

- Acceptable Standard in FLA 30-1, Soc 30-1, and ELA. 30-2;
- Sustaining improvement at the Acceptable Standard in ELA. 30-1 and Soc 30-2;
- Standard of Excellence in Soc. 30-1, Chem 30, and Physics 30;
- **Professional learning** to support improvement in FLA 30-1.
