We are hopeful that as the vaccine roll out continues to include younger age brackets, we will begin to see COVID-19 numbers across the province decline. At this time, some of our neighboring jurisdictions have applied for and been granted permission from the Ministry to transition their grade 7-12 students to online learning for the next two weeks. We are pleased to report that at this time GSACRD schools do not meet the threshold of numbers required to be considered for a switch to online learning. We will continue to monitor our own COVID-19 numbers and the provincial situation to ensure that we are making the best possible decisions for our students' learning and their safety.

We will continue to adhere to <u>Step 1</u> health measures and update our <u>Parent Guidebook for School</u> <u>Re-Entry: 2020-2021</u> as well as our <u>website</u> and official social media channels (<u>Facebook</u>, <u>Twitter</u>, and <u>Instagram</u>), which are also reliable sources of Division news.

Although the Division will not be piloting the draft curriculum at this time, we seek to work collaboratively with Alberta Education to provide feedback on the new curriculum. We invite interested staff and families to "have your say" by participating in the Draft K-6 Curriculum - Public Feedback Survey.

I would like to thank all of our staff and families for their support as we continue to navigate this time of pandemic, tending to student learning needs, while working to protect the health and well-being of our school communities. We consistently pray for the wellness of our staff, students, and families, and I would like to leave you with words from the Third Letter of the Holy Apostle John:

"Beloved, I pray that all may go well with you and that you may be in good health, just as it is well with your soul." (3 John 2)
