

TRAFFIC AND PARKING CONTROL

Background

Efficient management of staff and student parking contributes to the creation of a safe environment for students, employees and the public.

The District shall provide adequate parking facilities for its employees and may provide limited parking for students where a need exists and there is adequate space.

Procedures

1. The District does not assume any responsibility or liability for vehicles parked on its property.
2. Parking fees may be set annually to recover a portion of capital, operating and maintenance costs.
3. Regulations and fee recommendations for student parking may be determined by the Principal, subject to Board approval.
4. Traffic control in school bus lanes shall be regulated by the Secretary-Treasurer by:
 - 4.1 Establishing school bus lanes at all District schools.
 - 4.2 Arranging for appropriate signage to restrict and/or prohibit parking in school bus lanes.
 - 4.3 Issuing appropriate violation warning notices where required.
 - 4.4 Arranging for the legal ticketing or removal of offending vehicles when necessary.
